SUMMER PRAYER:

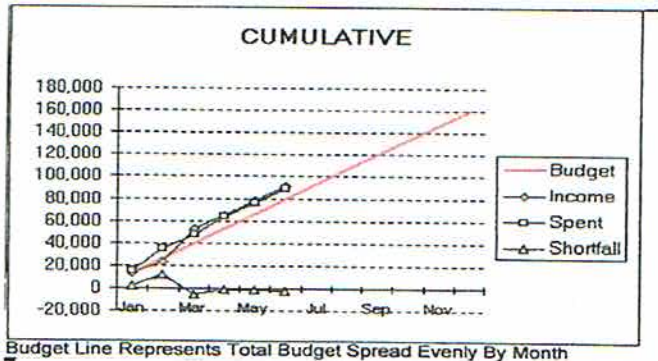
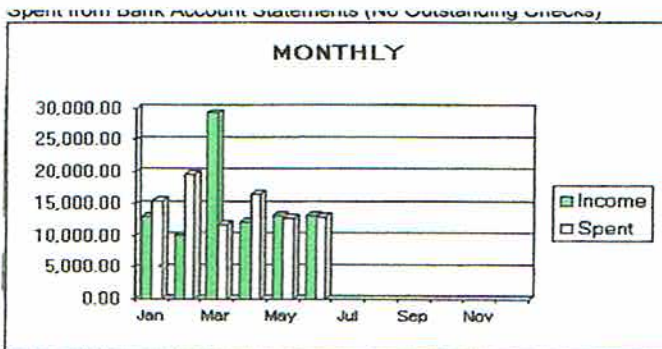
