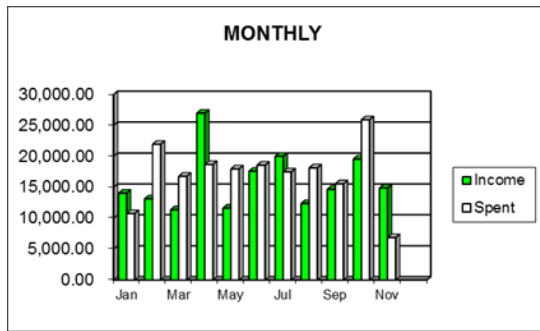

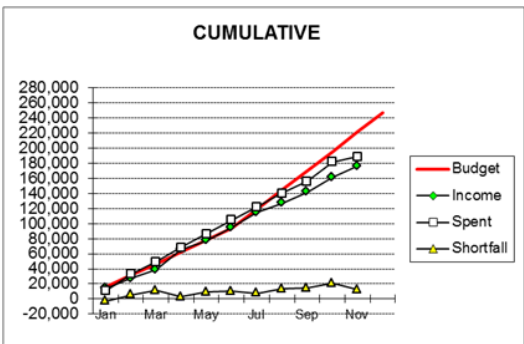

Evenly by Month

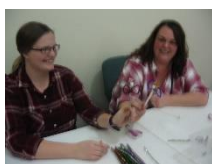
