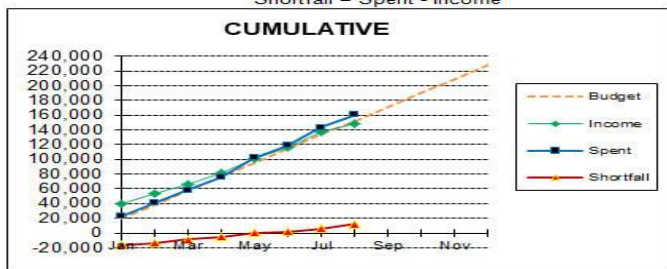
From Pastor Leo.....

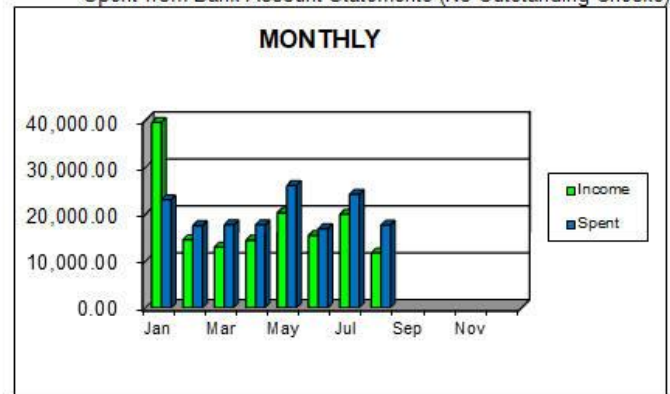
